- Vision: A reminder that the best and most beautiful thing about motherhood is Jesus himself, who is with her always.


My prayer for *you* is that you would...

ACTIVITY TIME!

Gather the guests together and have a seat. Give everyone a fun-size bag of M&M's or Skittles and have each person pull one candy out. Each color indicates what icebreaker question they will answer. WISDOM CARDS

Once everyone has written their blessing, encouragement, challenge or kind advice, have everyone go around and read them aloud. Afterward, you can give all the cards to mom as a keepsake.

Once cards are filled out and read to the mom to encourage her, end with a time of prayer. If you need something to pray, there's a prayer from Laura on the page after the cards. You can even print out that prayer and give it to your guest of honor!


