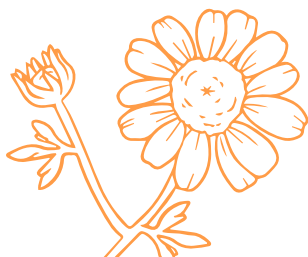
**Note:** *it's best to print these and copy them onto cardstock so that they last longer for the years to come!*
